<i>Undertakes full assessment</i>	Primary Survey, in addition records Pulse, B/P, SaO <sub>2</sub> , respiratory rates, Temp., GCS, CRT	Primary survey conducted but no patient observations recorded following this	No primary survey recorded but patient observations are taken	No structured assessment undertaken
<i>Communicates appropriately with patient</i>	Explains interventions; calms and reassures pt; checks for understanding	Explains to patient; could be more effective in establishing rapport	Shows some communication ability; displays caring but not competence	Explanations are confusing; patient is made anxious and not reassured
<i>Seeks patient history</i>	Complete history obtained using SAMPLE, pain assessment-PQRSTA, family history, social history, current medications	Complete history obtained in an unstructured way	Incomplete history obtained	No significant history obtained
<i>Identifies potential diagnosis</i>	Considers non-cardiac causes of chest pain Correct interpretation of ECG	Looks at ECG and asks colleagues to confirm their interpretation	Does not look at ECG; asks colleagues to interpret	Makes no attempt to interpret ECG
<i>Commences treatment</i>	Aspirin Oxygen Position	Partially treated	Treatment considered but not given	No treatment commenced
<b>Point of patient deterioration – 4 minutes into scenario</b>				
<i>Recognises deterioration</i>	Seeks assistance Via MET call/code blue and other staff	Seeks assistance from other nurses/doctor	Pages doctor for assistance	Does not seek help
<i>Situational awareness</i>	demonstrated Awareness of surroundings	Some awareness of surroundings	Minimal awareness	No demonstration of awareness of surroundings
<i>Continues treatment</i>	Oxygen continues (non rebreather) Nitrates Morphine IV cannulation	Partial treatment continued	Treatment considered but not continued	No further treatment given
<i>Ongoing</i>	Airway, breathing			

<i>Assessment</i>	circulation reassessed Vital signs and pain score repeated	Vital signs repeated	Vital signs partially repeated	No vital signs or evidence of primary survey
<i>Communication</i>	Reassuring communication with patient	Adequate communication with patient	Participant communicates minimally with patient	No attempt to communicate with patient and reassure
<i>Timeliness of interventions</i>	All interventions/actions conducted in a timely manner	Interventions/actions completed but in an untimely manner	Incomplete interventions	No interventions completed
